If you have any questions, please ask your child's class teacher.

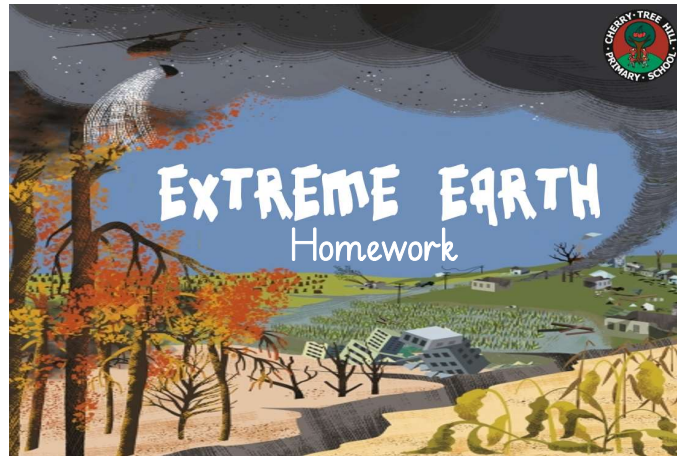

Project 1 –

Project 3 –

Project 6 –

Write a diary entry for someone who has just experienced a natural disaster at their home. BBC Newsround online is a good source of information.

Project 5 –

Recycle an empty bottle to measure the rainfall in your garden! Cut the bottle in half and use a measuring jug to mark on the quantities of water. Leave in your garden and see how much rain you can collect, this will be measured in cm<sup>3</sup>.

Project 4 –

Create a poster telling people what they should do if there is a flood.
