As Authors we will: write an explanation text linked to our science learning.

As Readers we will: Use our VIPERS skills to infer how people feel and how other people feel towards immigrants. We will also learn about migrants.

As mathematicians we will: look at finding angles within shapes and draw the nets for 3D shapes. We will also improve our skills in multiplying and dividing by 10, 100, 1000 and in calculating decimals and percentages.

As Online Safety experts we will: assess and action different strategies to limit the impact of technology on my health.

As Linguists we will: learn about healthy lifestyles- listening attentively to spoken language and show understanding by joining in.

WHAT WE ARE LEARNING:

As Historians we will: look at key countries that people emigrate from or have sought refuge from and look at the key events that have occurred in some of these countries such as the Windrush. Why did people emigrate in the past compared to now?

As Geographers we will: locate countries focusing on Europe and South America and North America. We will look at the different environmental factors and compare social/economics of some countries. Which countries have War/conflict? Why do people want to move to UK?

As Scientists we will: identify and name the main parts of the circulatory system and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood. We will describe the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within humans. We will look at the impact of diet and exercise on our bodies.

Wow Event/Hook: We will learn from the visit of the 'UpBeat Communities charity' who will come in to talk to the children about the work that they do in supporting refugees who come to Derby. We will also have a visit from the Red Cross charity who will deliver an empathy plus migration workshop

As Musicians we will: compose music using musical notations and improvise music for a range of purposes. We will play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts using voices and simple instruments with increasing accuracy, control and expression.

As Artists/Designers we will: learn about great artists, architects and designers in History, e.g. David Hockney and master our paint skills.

As Athletes we will: develop ball skills and understanding of competitive sports through Tennis and Netball. We will continue to improve our fitness.

As Citizens we will: continue to look at charity and generosity in RE. In PHSCE lessons we will focus on 'Healthy Me' looking at how to take responsibility for your own health physically and mentally.
