Project 1 –

Create a crossword with vocabulary from this topic.

Project 2 –

Conduct a survey to find out what people's favourite Greek food is. Present your results in a pictogram or bar chart.



Project 3 –

Choose your own project related to Ancient Greece. Surprise me with your creativity!

Project 6 –

Draw and label a map of Greece and plan a trip there. Which modes of transport would you use to get there from your house? Which countries would you pass through or over?

Project 5 –

Find out some simple Greek phrases. E.g. Hello, How are you? What's your name? Etc. Can you make a poster to display them in Greek & English? Make sure you can pronounce them correctly and teach them to the class.

Project 4 –

Research one of the Greek Gods or Goddesses. Find out about their powers and any myths that are related to them. Write a fact file about them. This could be Zeus, Athena, Hades etc.
