- Mr Dursley shouts at Ron on the telephone
- They are fearful
  - They lock away Harry's magic possessions
  - Mr Dursley denies that Hogwarts exists
  - Mr Dursley threw the phone down like it was a poisonous spider when talking to Ron
- They are set in their ways/unchangeable
  - They have a medieval view of magic
- They care about how they are seen by others or the opinions of others
  - Harry's parents are never spoken about because they were a witch and a wizard.
  - They live in terror of the neighbours finding out that Harry has been to Hogwarts.
  - They forbid him to talk to the neighbours
  - They admired the new company car 'very loudly' so the neighbours would hear.
