Speaking & Listening: perform a poem as a class, using actions and a text map to support.

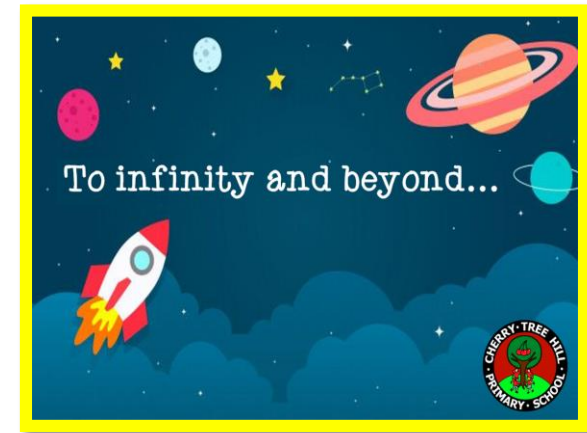
PSHE- Jigsaw theme: Relationships and how we can be kind to others.
