Our Schools Badminton Programme has been designed to provide high-quality coaching, increase participation in physical activity, and create clear pathways for children to continue playing badminton beyond the school environment. The programme is open to all children from Year 4 – Year 6 and can be delivered at times that best suit your school, including: • Before school clubs • Curriculum time sessions • Lunchtime clubs • After school clubs Schools will receive: • 12 hours of badminton coaching • Delivered over a flexible programme to suit individual school requirements • Designed specifically for Years 4, 5 and 6. Where needed, schools may also access their sessions at The Bemrose School, our designated hub school, allowing pupils to benefit from the use of a full-sized sports hall and specialist badminton facilities. Otherwise, the programme can be delivered in primary school halls. All sessions are delivered by Badminton England qualified coach Donna Kellogg, a 3 x Olympian from Derby and other qualified coaches who have previously coached primary school children. Coaches will: • Hold appropriate Badminton England coaching qualifications • Be DBS checked • Hold relevant safeguarding training • Be experienced in delivering engaging sessions for primary-aged children	Sessions focus on: • Engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity • Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils • To increase badminton participation amongst primary school children. • Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport • Fundamental movement skills • Hand-eye coordination • Agility, balance and coordination • Badminton-specific skills • Teamwork and sportsmanship • Competitive play

Playing Opportunities: Primary School → Secondary School → Junior Club Badminton → Adult Club and League Badminton Children wishing to continue their badminton journey outside of these sessions will be signposted towards: • Local junior badminton clubs • Community coaching sessions • Development opportunities within Derbyshire Children displaying exceptional ability may also be referred through direct links with the Derbyshire Badminton Association for further development opportunities.	We are committed to supporting schools beyond the coaching programme through: • A dedicated local point of contact • Advice and guidance for teachers • Ongoing badminton development support • Assistance with embedding badminton into PE provision We will also: • Monitor local junior club participation following school sessions • Identify increases in membership linked to school delivery • Provide feedback to schools where appropriate • Encourage and gather feedback from teachers to continually improve the programme
Signposting to suitable community badminton exit routes	• Offer direct links signposting the children to local clubs / coaching sessions allowing them the opportunity to improve their badminton skills • Increase opportunities to competitive sport • A direct link with Derbyshire Badminton Association for those children displaying exceptional talent •
Local point of contact for any ongoing future support to embed badminton within school	• Support if needed for teachers after the coaching has been completed • Monitor the local junior coaching sessions to establish if there has been increase of membership which is directly linked to the schools coaching sessions • Feed back to the schools • Encourage feedback from the teachers
Cost to School	£350 - This includes: • 12 hours of qualified badminton coaching • DBS checked and fully qualified coaches • Flexible delivery before, during or after school • Access to competition opportunities • Pathways into local club and county badminton • Teacher support and ongoing guidance • Access to The Bemrose School sports hall if required for delivery
