If you have any questions, please ask your child's class teacher.

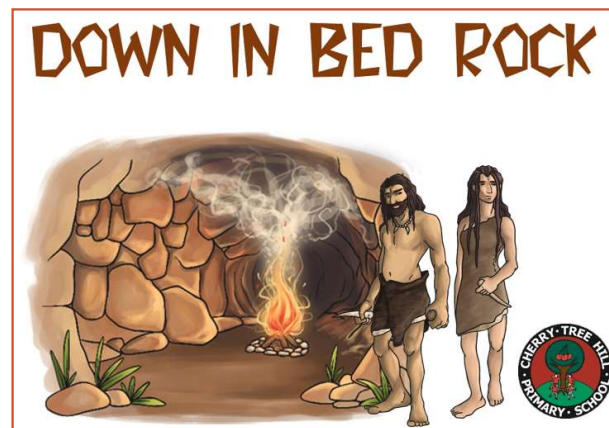
