Religious Education:

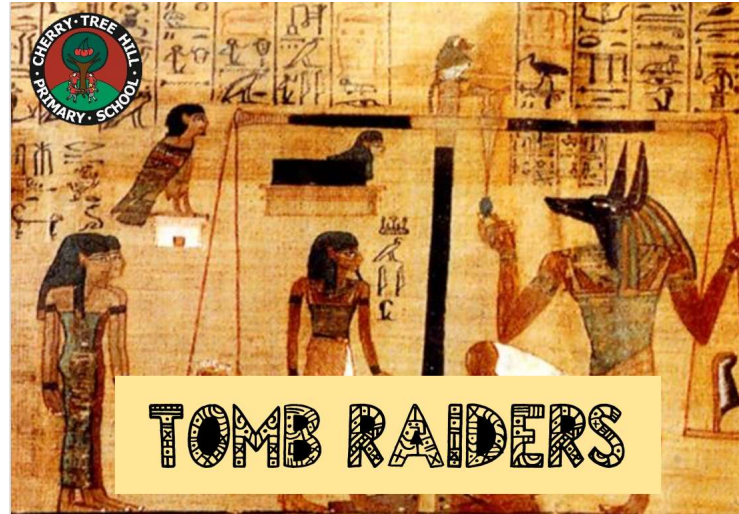
- What do different people believe
