Academic Year 2016-2017 Evaluation

Strengths – 100% of new teaching staff have attended CPD for games, gymnastics and dance. 2 staff members trained on the Physical Literacy intervention program. 19 x SSP events entered – 111% increase on last year. 3 x 5 a side league teams entered – 50% increase on last year. 2 x 7-a-side teams entered – new for this year. 2 9-a-side teams entered – new for this year. 1 x high 5 league entered. 1 x Derby County tournament teams entered. 72% of our children have had the opportunity to represent Cherry Tree Hill Primary in an event. Cherry Tree Hill Primary School made it to County Finals in Boccia.

Derby County supported after school sessions and worked with the Year 5 children on the Move and Learn programme, in addition worked for a term delivering PPA cover. 100% of our Year 4, 5 and 6 pupil premium children attended a sports club at lunchtime with Derby County. Sports week Summer 2016 and sports day were successful. KS1 and KS2 equipment updated. Spare kit has been purchased and all children participate in PE unless there is a medical reason. Varied sports across the school show that the scheme of work is being followed. Daily Physical Activity has been introduced at lunchtime with the play leaders.

Weaknesses – Staff need to ensure that children are participating in two sessions a week of PE, indoor and outdoor (weather permitting).

Opportunities – Derby County upskilling staff. SSP working with us to upskill staff. Active Schools team support. Opportunity for children to participate in clubs and more opportunity for children to be part of a team and compete against other schools.

Key areas for development – Continue with clubs, competitions and festivals to give KS2 children the opportunity to compete against other schools. A rolling CPD programme for new staff. FS and KS1 to be given Physical Literacy Training. KS2 staff to go on OAA training. Monitoring of lessons. FS2 to be given support to enhance PE lessons by Livewell/SSP/DCCT. Increase participation in festivals and competitions for FS and KS1.
