Academic Year 2015-2016 Evaluation

Strengths – 100% of teaching staff have attended CPD. 9 x SSP events entered. 2 x 5 a side league teams entered. 1 x high 5 league entered. 2 x Derby County tournament teams entered. Derby County supported after school sessions and worked with the Year 5 children on the RESPECT program. Premier Sports worked with Y5/6 on Olympic sports that teachers are less confident in teaching. Sports week Summer 2015 and sports day were successful, as was the Run event on Chaddesden Park for the whole school. KS1 and KS2 equipment updated. Spare kit has been purchased and all children participate in PE unless there is a medical reason. Varied sports across the school shows that the scheme of work is being followed.

Weaknesses – Staff need to ensure that children are participating in two sessions a week of PE. Children can go outdoors for their lessons.

Opportunities – Derby County upskilling staff. Premier Sports upskilling staff. Opportunity for children to participate in clubs and more opportunity for children to be part of a team and compete against other schools.

Key areas for development – Clubs, competitions and festivals to be entered to give different children the opportunity to compete against other schools, another survey of staff weaknesses, CPD for staff, support for staff to upskill through use of external coaches, Ensure Long Term and Medium Term plan for the whole school is followed, Monitoring of lessons. FS2 to be given support to enhance PE lessons by Livewell/SSP/DCCT.
