School Games Mark

Schools with Key Stage 2 pupils are encouraged to apply for the national School Games Mark (Bronze, Silver or Gold). Below provides a summary of the criteria. For support with your application please come along to our School Games Mark Clinic (see below) or e-mail info@derbycityssp.co.uk.

Curriculum:

Bronze: Plans for two hours of Physical Education and School Sport per week.

Silver: Provide pupils with two hours of Physical Education and School Sport per week.

Gold: Provide all students with two hours of Physical Education per week with extra-curricular activities as additional.

Extra-curricular:

Bronze: Engage 20% of KS2 pupils in extra-curricular sporting activity every week.

Silver: Engage 35% of KS2 pupils in extra-curricular sporting activity every week.

Gold: Engage 50% of KS2 pupils in extra-curricular sporting activity every week & offer talented young sports people specific support.




