| Boudicca | The Queen of the Iceni tribe who led a rebellion against the Romans in 60AD |
| Prasutagas | The Iceni king and Boudicca's husband. |
| Iceni | Boudicca's tribe which lived in East Anglia. |
| Gladius | A short sword used by the Romans for quick sharp stabbing in battle. |
| Chariot | The a light weight carriage pulled by two horses used for fast attacks. |
| Legion | The largest Roman military unit consisting of 5,600 infantry and 200 auxilia. |
| Watling Street | A Roman road running across the middle of England. |
| Celts | People living in Britain in tribes, including the Iceni, Brigantes and Catuvellauni. |
| empire | A group of countries controlled by one ruler (emperor or empress) or government. |
| AD | means Anno Domini, indicates how many years after Jesus the events happened. |
| roundhouse | a type of settlement used from bronze age right through to Anglo-Saxon times. |
| Britons | The Celts who lived in England. They were split into smaller groups called tribes. |
