Vikings and Anglo-Saxons had to be fit and strong.: create an exercise regime to support this, including exercises that help with training for conflicts. Share your regime with a family member or friend. Keep and exercise diary to show us in class.

Using what we have learnt about Vikings myths and legends, write your own epic Viking Saga about a hero who battles monsters, Saxons and the wild seas!



Research what the Vikings thought about death. Where do they believe they go when they die? What rituals did they practice?

Select a famous figure from the Anglo Saxon or Viking era. Draw, paint or collage a picture of them. It could be a king, soldier, God or legendary hero.

Research a Viking God or Goddess and create a fact file about them. This could be done on the computer or on paper, be creative with your presentation of the information, could you add some art work too?

Create a model of a Saxon town or castle. You can use any materials you like. Include a list of the features using the vocabulary we have learned and describe how it is defended.
